

PA SPECIAL PURPOSE ENTITY PROGRAM

The Pennsylvania EITC/OSTC Special Purpose Entity (SPE) Program allows individuals with a PA state income tax liability in excess of \$3,500 to donate to St. John the Baptist Catholic School and receive a PA state tax credit for 90% of their donation each year. The remaining 10% of their donation is a deductible charitable contribution for federal tax purposes. These tax credit contributions will allow St. John the Baptist Catholic School to provide scholarships for those students and families most in need.

A Special Purpose Entity allows individuals to gain PA tax credits by donating tuition scholarships to schools! You are eligible if your PA state tax amounts to \$3,500+.

Your tax dollars will directly support the tuition of our students!

THREE STEPS... AS EASY AS S.P.E.!

SEND

in your joinder application ASAP.

PAY

your tuition scholarship donation once your tax credit is approved by PA state.

ENTER

your contribution on your PA tax return for a 90% tax credit.



FAQs on Special Purpose Entity (SPE)

Can these credits be used on both individual and joint income tax returns?

• Yes, you qualify if your individual or combined PA tax liability is \$3,500 or more.

If I participate in these tax credits, how much will it cost me?

• Upon acceptance, you will be asked to make an out-of-pocket donation, up to the amount of your annual state taxes. Early the following year, you will receive a K-1 statement to be used when you file your taxes in the spring. The K-1 will qualify you to receive a refund of 90% of your donation from your PA state income tax liability and a federal tax deduction for the remaining 10% of your donation.

What percentage of my contribution goes to the school of my choice?

 100% of your contribution goes to St. John the Baptist Catholic School to be distributed as tuition assistance for students and families who qualify for financial aid. No portion of your donation is used for administrative purposes – every dollar goes directly to help those who most need your support.

How do I indicate the school or tuition scholarship fund that is to receive my contribution?

• On your Joinder Form, please note St. John the Baptist Catholic School in the space designated for "Name of School" and indicate the tax credit amount for which you are applying in the place designated "Amount \$."

Do I need to reapply to the SPE each year?

Yes. Each year you are contacted and asked to reinvest. If you choose not to continue
in the program, simply do not complete the form, and the tax credits
will be available to another donor applicant.

Help St. John the Baptist Catholic School Through Tuition Scholarship Tax Credit Programs

The following is an example based on \$10,000 of state income tax liability. Households may start to participate at \$3,500.


Patrick is in the 37% tax bracket and itemizes his deductions. He donates a \$10,000 tuition scholarship to St. John the Baptist Catholic School, a private Catholic school that participates in the PA EITC/SPE program.

For his donation, Patrick receives a 90% PA tax credit, and a \$370 charitable gift deduction on his federal taxes.

With the EITC/SPE tax credits, Patrick's net out of pocket is \$630. pocket is \$630.

Tuition Scholarship Donation	\$10,000
PA Tax Credit	(\$9,000)*
Federal Tax Charitable Gift Deduction	\$370
Net Out of Pocket	\$630

*Important to make sure your expected PA tax is greater than this; excess credit money is lost. Note: PA tax rate is 3.07%.

Supporting education through Special Purpose Entities (SPE)

What is SPE?

Special Purpose Entity is a pass-through partnership that exists solely for the purpose of earning Educational Improvement Tax Credits. CPSF is a non-profit that manages various SPEs at *no* cost to the school.

Who can participate?

Any individual or corporation that pays PA income tax is eligible.

There are options for individuals who work for non-profits, state employees, and retirees.

The minimum donation to join an SPE is \$3,500 with CPSF.

How does it work?

Reallocate taxpayers' money to a tuitionbased school instead of going to Harrisburg

Taxpayers will receive 90% state tax credit for their total donation.

When itemizing deductions, the taxpayer can use the other 10% as a federal tax credit as a charitable donation.

Credit disbursement happens usually end of August the following year.

CPSF distributes funds to participating schools to provide student scholarships.

The school receives 100% of the donation.
