After Communion – Altar Clearing		
1	<p>After receiving communion and Priest and other ministers depart altar to distribute communion. (See Diagrams)</p> <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only the Missal/Stand are removed. • The items that are typically removed are placed on the Host Corporal to be purified by the Priest. • Items on the Center Corporal are treated as usual. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Remove Missal/Stand and hand to 2nd Server. <u>Organize items on altar per diagrams:</u> 2. Move to the Host Corporal those items that are typically removed: Chalice / Paten / Pall / Purificator. 3. Place on Center Corporal: large Ciborium, lid, and any pyx (closed). Note: If lid is on the Ciborium, leave it there. 4. Bow to altar and return to verify Missal is open to the Prayer After Communion (seasonal color ribbon). 5. Stand on top step next to brick wall during communion.
Purifying Vessels at Altar		
2	When Priest returns to the altar after distributing communion.	Retrieve water <u>only</u> and stand on top step with other Servers.
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	Cue	Action
3	When Priest genuflects to Our Lord upon returning large Ciborium to the tabernacle	Genuflect facing tabernacle and proceed to Priest with water and present water to him. Remain there until water is returned. as he returns to altar.
4	When Priest returns water.	Return water to credence table and then stand at top step with other Servers prepared to retrieve Ciboria
Retrieving Vessels		
5	As Priest finishes wiping out/purifying Ciboria and places them on corner of altar.	With other Servers, retrieve Ciboria from corner of altar and return to credence table.
6	When Priest finishes "assembling" the Chalice.	Ensure a Server retrieves Chalice and Corporal from Priest and returns them to credence table.
