GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

Linda Glock was a long-time parishioner of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church. Her passion was music, education, and her Catholic faith. During her life, Linda participated in many aspects of the music ministry at St. John's - Daystar, choir, cantor, piano, and funeral liturgy. For many years, she taught religious education and always reached out to help friends and family members in need. Linda died in 2011 after a courageous, faith-filled battle with melanoma.

An annual scholarship is offered in her memory.

SELECTION OF WINNERS

The Linda Marie Glock Memorial Scholarship recipient will be chosen among qualified submitted scholarship applications. Deadline for applications is **March 8, 2022**.

AMOUNT OF AWARD

The amount of the award is determined annually by the LMG Scholarship Committee.

REQUIREMENTS OF STUDENTS APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- Graduating senior
- Registered parishioner of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church – Letter of verification obtained from church office. (May be signed by pastor or office staff)
- Minimum of one-year participation in St. John's music ministry during high school – youth choir, adult choir, Daystar, Youth band, cantor, instrumentalist, etc. - Letter verifying participation obtained from St. John's music director or group leader.
- Acceptance in a college, university, or trade school. Acceptance letter must be presented to committee by recipient of award. Any major.
- Two letters of reference from teachers, guidance counselor, employer, or mentor.
- Essay of 300 words or less on "What St. John's Music Ministry has meant to me." Must be typed and double-spaced.
- Completed application form.
- All applications along with letters verifying being registered parishioners and participation in music ministry, letters of reference and completed essays need to be submitted to St. John's office by **March 8, 2021**.

REQUIREMENT TO RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIP

Winner receives scholarship when accepted *and* enrolled in school mentioned above.
