Lectio: God

What do we mean when we say "God"? Even among Christians, misconceptions can become obstacles in our relationship with God. Dr. Elizabeth Klein will bring you to a clearer awareness of who God is, and equip you to share this truth with others. In the Old Testament, Dr. Klein presents how God reveals to Israel that "the Lord is one" (Deuteronomy 6:4). Moving into the New Testament, she shows how this one God then reveals himself as three. Discover: "If God is one, how can Jesus be God? What does it mean that 'God is love'? Why is the doctrine of the trinity the central mystery of our faith when the word 'Trinity' never appears in the Bible?"
